SITE POLICY ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:

By applying for training courses with the Wisconsin Operating Engineers Training Center, I understand that it is my responsibility to familiarize myself and comply with the policies and procedures in place to ensure the rights of all students in attendance. Site policies are available at all IUOE Local 139 offices, or you may view them any time on our website at 139training.org. I further acknowledge that it is my responsibility to keep myself updated on any changes to these policies.

DRESS CODE & PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:

All members using the Training Center must wear shirts with sleeves (no tank tops or sleeveless shirts), full length work pants (no sweat pants, shorts, or pajamas) and no sandals or open-toed shoes.

OSHA regulation work clothes and PPE (hard hat, gloves, work boots, etc.) are required for all field training. You will also need appropriate cold weather gear; all courses include hands-on exercises or demonstrations that may require outdoor training.

PER DIEM FOR MEMBERS OF LOCAL 139:

Members of Local 139 in good standing are eligible to receive \$20/day per diem FOR COURSES HELD AT THE JOSEPH J. GOETZ TRAINING CENTER IN COLOMA. Per Diem will be paid only for full days of attendance. It is NOT paid for 1, 2 or 3 day courses. Per Diem is NOT paid for make-up days or days the individual is late or leaves early.

All Local 139 Union Membership obligations, including dues, must be current to be eligible to attend training.

APPRENTICE COURSE FEES:

40 hour course: \$210.00

80 hour course: \$370.00

Transition to Trainer: \$40.00

All course fees are collected on the first day of the course. Course fees apply to training for your apprenticeship that are accredited through the Technical College system. These fees may be reimbursable through the ACAP grant, you will receive information for this by email from the DWD. Please save all course receipts to submit for this reimbursement.



2026-2027 Registration Policies

Notice to All Members of Operating Engineers Local 139:

The Operating Engineers Local 139 Training Center is committed to providing members and apprentices with access to training opportunities throughout the training season. Registration procedures and eligibility requirements vary based on the type of training and, for apprentices, total hours earned and sign-in date.

Registration

• *Registration for Health and Safety classes* and refresher courses will be available online or by calling the Training Center starting on **Monday, October 5, 2026**.

• *Registration for equipment-based classes* for NON-APPRENTICE members will be limited to **two** seats and available by calling the Training Center starting on **Monday, October 5, 2026**.

Online registration will not be available for equipment-based classes.

• Members may also register by completing the registration form located on pages 21–22 of the training catalog. Completed forms may be returned to the Training Center office by mail, fax or email.

Alternate Position Registration (for Elective Classes)

- Any NON-APPRENTICE member may hold **only two alternate positions at a time**.
- Once a class has commenced, you may obtain another alternate position.
- Being placed on the alternate list does not guarantee a seat in the class.
- If a seat becomes available, the Training Center will offer the seat to the first eligible alternate on the list, subject to all applicable eligibility requirements.

Apprentices seeking an alternate position for an elective class must meet the following requirements:

- Have completed the first-year classes:
 - Basic Equipment
 - Basic Maintenance
 - Construction Regulations
- Have more than 1,500 total hours
- Alternate seats will **ADD** to maximum allowable scheduled related instruction hours

Confirmation of Attendance

- Members and apprentices who are registered for a class are required to respond to a phone call or email from the Training Center to confirm their availability and intention to attend.
- The required confirmation must be received no later than 4:00 PM on Wednesday prior to the scheduled class.

Failure to Confirm

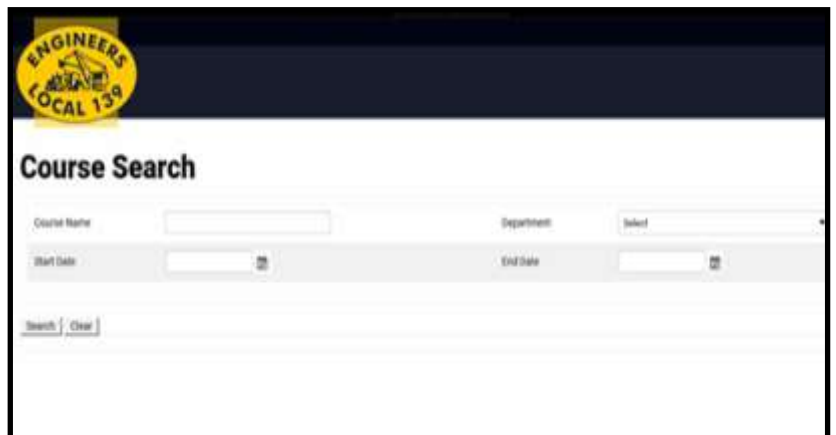
- If the Training Center does not receive a response by 4:00 PM on Wednesday prior to the class, the individual's seat will be considered **forfeited**.
- The forfeited seat may then be offered to the first eligible alternate on the alternate list.
- Members and apprentices are responsible for maintaining current contact information with the Training Center and for responding promptly to Training Center communications.

Registration Acknowledgment

- Once a member or apprentice has been accepted into a class, the individual will be required to sign an **Acknowledgment of Registration Policies form**.
- Members and apprentices are responsible for reviewing their eligibility before registering and for following all Training Center registration procedures. The Training Center may establish reasonable administrative procedures necessary to manage enrollment, alternate lists, course capacity, attendance confirmation, and related instruction requirements.

Apprentices Signed-In Prior to January 1, 2026

Apprentice registration is based on the apprentice's sign-in date, total hours earned, and maximum allowable related instruction.

October 5, 2026 — 4,500 Hours or More

Registration will open on Monday, October 5, 2026, for apprentices who:

- Have 4,500 or more total hours
- May register for up to **400 total hours** of related instruction

October 12, 2026 — 3,000–4,499 Hours

Registration will open on Monday, October 12, 2026, for apprentices who:

- Have 3,000–4,499 total hours
- May register for up to **400 total hours** of related instruction

October 19, 2026 — 1,500–2,999 Hours

Registration will open on Monday, October 19, 2026, for apprentices who:

- Have 1,500–2,999 total hours
- May register for up to **320 total hours** of related instruction

Certifications & Qualifications

40 Hour Hazmat (1 Week)

This course will provide basic information needed to protect HAZWOPER Site Workers from health, physical, and biological hazards. This course meets the requirements of OSHA 29 CFR 1910.120 (Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response) and OSHA 29 CFR 1910.146 (Permit Required Confined Space). Training will be a combination of both hands-on and classroom instruction. *40 hours*

Required for Registered Apprentices contracted in 2025.

Certification will need to be refreshed every 12 months.

Disaster Site Worker (1 Week)

This is a one week course that integrates the OSHA 10 Hour program for General Industry, ICS 100, and Disaster Site Worker into the overall class curriculum and is intended to provide the basic understanding of the role of skilled support workers in response to natural and man-made disasters. A key element to the learning objectives is to increase awareness of the difference between disaster sites and regular construction or demolition sites. Successful participants will be able to demonstrate a clear understanding of the Incident Command System, the proper inspection and use of an air-purifying respirator and other key points. The goal of this course is to establish a growing contingent of appropriately credentialed operating engineers who are recognized and may be called upon by emergency response organizations at all levels of government. *40 hours*

Topics will cover the latest developments in the HAZMAT industry, as well as general construction safety.

Students must have taken the 40-hour HAZMAT prior to taking this course and must take this refresher every year to keep your HAZMAT certification current. 8 hours

Topics covered include miner's rights, rules and procedures for reporting hazards, and hazard identification. This course includes the required 8 hours of First Aid/CPR/AED training. *24 hours*

Certification will need to be refreshed every 12 months.
